Visit Cebu's historical sites and landmarks. First stop is Fort San Pedro, the oldest triangular fortress in the country built in

1565. Then proceed to Magellan's Cross, a monument built to commemorate Magellan's landing in Cebu of which the original bamboo cross is preserved inside another wooden cross. A few steps away is the Basilica Minore del Santo Niño, built by Miguel Lopez de Legazpi in 1565, now housing the statuette of Santo Niño or the Child Jesus. One of the highlights of the tour is the Kenneth Cobonpue showroom which showcases the unique and incredible works of the world renowned Filipino furniture maker. Also see the Cebu Heritage Monument built in 2000 which institutionalizes significant sites, events and personalities of the province. Museo Sugbo is a new museum inaugurated in 2008 highlighting the history and culture of Cebu. Once called the Carcel de Cebu, the structure built in 1869, was used as the main prison for the Visayas District by the Spanish government. The venerable structure holds antiques and artifacts collected through the centuries. The tour also visits the Profood Dried Mango Factory which takes guests through the history and process of producing one of the world's most sought-after delicacies. Guests will have the opportunity to buy their favorite dried fruits at the factory.

First Stop: CARCAR CITY

Carcar is known for its locally-made shoes and other kinds of footwear, bolo making and basket weaving are also some of the prevalent cottage industries among the Carcaranons. Aside from these, Carcaranons are also into wooden furniture manufacturing and antique reproduction. Carcar is also known for its delicious meaty chicharon which one cannot stop eating when started. Carcar is also proud of its heritage houses.

Second Stop: SIMALA, SIBONGA

The Mother Mary Shrine in Simala draws thousands of devotees and first-time pilgrims every year bringing their faith and petitions for Divine aid and cure. One can write their petitions on a sheet of paper which could be dropped near the encased Marian image. The Marian monks who maintain the Shrine have also landscaped the area, which has a mini falls that cascades down a small.

Third Stop: ARGAO

The Church of Argao possesses one of the remaining fourteen (14) Spanish pipe organs in the Philippines. It is one of the only three remaining organs in the whole province built during the 17th to the 19th century by Spanish pipe organ makers. Argao Church became a parish in 1703, prompting the construction of a beautiful rococo-baroque church structure which started in 1734 and completed in 1788. The already renovated and modernized church, San Miguel Archangel Parish, still remains as one of the richly furnished churches in the South today. The famous Torta de Argao, baked in clay ovens using the traditional ingredients like tuba, is available and can be enjoyed with a hot cup of chocolate or tsokolate. The Cuartel Building, referred to as Apta Building, used to be the military barracks. Rehabilitated through the efforts of Chief Justice Hilario Davide, Jr., it is now used as the Hall of Justice


1100H Proceed to Bohol Countryside Tour with Lunch

The first stop is at the historic Blood Compact Shrine, a historical landmark commemorating the treaty of friendship between the conquistador Miguel Lopez de Legazpi and Datu Sikatuna. The next stop is the centuries-old Baclayon Church and museum which was partly damaged during the earthquake of 2013. En route to the Chocolate Hills, you drive through the lush Mahogany Man –Made Forest and the green farmland in Bilar and Batuan. View the 1,776 awesome cone-shaped limestone hills known as the Chocolate Hills from a viewing deck on top of one of these hills.


