UST Museum and Metropolitan Museum Tour

UST Museum - The University of Santo Tomas Museum is the oldest museum in the Philippines which dates back to 1871. The museum has a wide and interesting collection of Natural History, Oriental Art, Musical Instruments, Coins and many more.

MET Museum - The Metropolitan Museum of Manila is one of the major museums in the Philippines. The Museum is described by many artists as the best curated museum of modern art in the Philippines. The Met's collection gives one a cohesive perspective of the evolving Philippine art scene.

Proceed to Cebu Heritage Tour with Lunch

Visit Cebu's historical sites and landmarks. First stop is Fort San Pedro, the oldest triangular fortress in the country built in 1565. Then proceed to Magellan's Cross, a monument built to commemorate Magellan's landing in Cebu of which the original bamboo cross is preserved inside another wooden cross. A few steps away is the Basilica Minore del Santo Niño, built by Miguel Lopez de Legazpi in 1565, now housing the statuette of Santo Niño or the Child Jesus. One of the highlights of the tour is the Kenneth Cobonpue showroom which showcases the unique and incredible works of the world renowned Filipino furniture maker. Also see the Cebu Heritage Monument built in 2000 which captures significant sites, events and personalities of the province. Across the street is the Yap-Sandiego Ancestral





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House built in the late 1600s and one of the oldest houses in the Philippines. The venerable structure holds antiques and artifacts collected by the family through the centuries. The tour also visits the Profood Dried Mango Factory which takes guests through the history and process of producing one of the world's most sought-after delicacy. Guests will have the opportunity to buy their favorite dried fruits at the factory.

First Stop: **CARCAR**

Carcar is known for its locally-made shoes. Bolo making and basket weaving are also some of the prevalent cottage industries among the Carcaranons. Aside from these, Carcaranons are also into wooden furniture manufacturing and antique reproduction. Carcar is also known for its delicious meaty chicharon which one cannot stop eating when started.

Second Stop: **ARGAO**

The Church of Argao possesses one of the remaining fourteen (14) Spanish pipe organs in the Philippines. It is one of the only three remaining organs in the whole province built in the 17th to the 19th century by Spanish pipe organ makers. Argao became a parish in 1703, prompting the construction of a beautiful rococo-baroque church structure in 1734 and its completion in 1788. The already renovated and modernized church, San Miguel Archangel Parish, still remains as one of the richly furnished churches in the south today.

The famous Torta de Argao, baked in clay ovens using the traditional ingredients like tuba, is available and can be enjoyed with a hot cup of chocolate or tsokolate.

The Cuartel Building, referred to as Apta Building, used to be a military barracks and is now being used as the Hall of Justice. It was rehabilitated through the efforts of Chief Justice Hilario Davide, Jr.

Last Stop: **SIBONGA**

The Mother Mary Shrine in SIMALA draws thousands of devotees and first time pilgrims every year bringing their faith and petitions for divine aid and cure. One can write their petitions on a sheet of paper where they can drop it near the encased Marian image. The Marian monks who maintain the shrine have also landscaped the area, which has a mini falls that cascades down a small pool and well-tended gardens.

The first stop is at the historic Blood Compact Shrine, a historical landmark commemorating the treaty of friendship between the conquistador Miguel Lopez de Legazpi and Datu Sikatuna. The next stop is the centuries-old Baclayon Church and museum which was partly damaged during the earthquake of 2013. Enroute to the Chocolate Hills, you drive through the lush Mahogany Man -Made Forest and the green farmland in Bilar and Batuan. View the 1,776 awesome cone-shaped limestone hills known as the Chocolate Hills from a viewing deck on the top of one of these hills. Drive back to Loboc for a 50-minute river cruise along nipa-lined river on board a native catamaran. A sumptuous barbeque lunch is served on board. The river cruise will surely relax both your body and mind as you view nature's beauty of rolling hills, graceful coconut trees and green nipa palms lining the riverbanks. After the cruise, the tour then brings you back to Tagbilaran, after a brief stop to see the backyard industries in Loay (nipa weaving and knife making).
